Course Description

AutoCAD Advanced is the second in the series of AutoCAD courses and is designed to teach AutoCAD® users about the software's more advanced functionality. This training covers AutoCAD® new Action Recorder feature, which records the commands a user runs and automates tasks without programming experience, as well as the new Ribbon interface for accessing commands.
